We must remember that God instructed Moses (Peace Be Upon Him) to be lenient and soft towards Pharaoh, We must remember that we can never equal the status of Moses (Peace Be Upon Him) and the person whom we are giving Da'wah to can never equal the oppression which Pharaoh inflicted upon the Children of Israel.

[20:44] And speak to him with gentle speech that perhaps he may be reminded or fear [Allah]."
